The LPI library organizes and maintains a collection of space-science-related materials in a variety of media — including books, journals, documents, maps, and images — to facilitate lunar and planetary science research and disseminate science information to the public. The collection includes one of 17 international NASA Regional Planetary Image Facilities (RPIF). Library staff provide reference services upon request. Tours can be arranged during business hours.

LPI's unique library collection includes

- Historical documents from the Apollo program
- Negatives, positives, and prints from missions
- More than 60,000 catalogued books, documents, maps, globes, and videos
- A dedicated children's section containing nearly 1000 items
