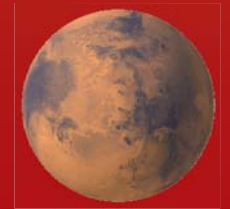




# MIND OVER MARS

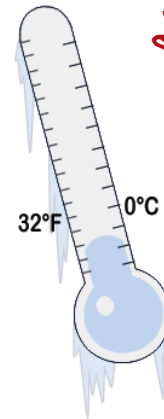


The martian DAY is 24 hours and 37 minutes.
