

**71ST ANNUAL METEORITICAL SOCIETY MEETING
Application for Student Travel Grant**

A limited number of student travel grants will be available. Undergraduate and graduate students as well as recent Ph.D.s are eligible to apply. Applicants must be a member of the Meteoritical Society, must be the sole or senior author, and must be the presenter. The purpose of the grants is to encourage those with limited sources of funding to attend the meeting. Applicants will be notified as soon as possible of the decision of the Program Committee.

In the event that there are insufficient funds to support all the competitive abstracts submitted, the Program Committee needs information about previous Society travel awards received. Student applicants must also provide a copy of their current resume.

The deadline for ALL application materials is **MAY 7, 2008** (the same date as the abstract deadline). Students not submitting their application form AND resume by this date will not be considered for the award.
