A limited number of student travel grants and several awards will be available. Undergraduate and graduate students as well as recent Ph.D.s (within the last two years) are eligible to apply. Applicants must be a member of the Meteoritical Society, must be the sole or senior author, and must be the presenter. The purpose of the grants is to encourage those with limited sources of funding to attend the meeting. Grant applicants will be notified as soon as possible of the decision of the Program Committee.

The deadline for *all* application materials is **APRIL 28, 2009** (the same date as the abstract deadline).
