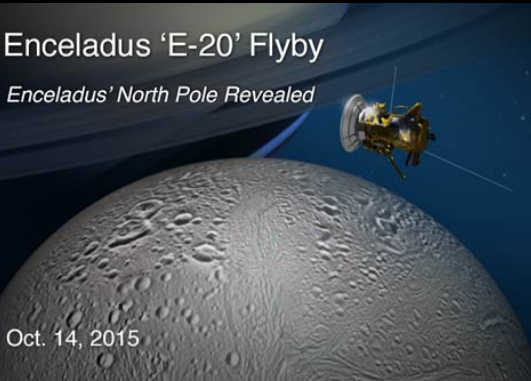


Revealing Enceladus' North Pole

Enceladus 'E-20' Flyby

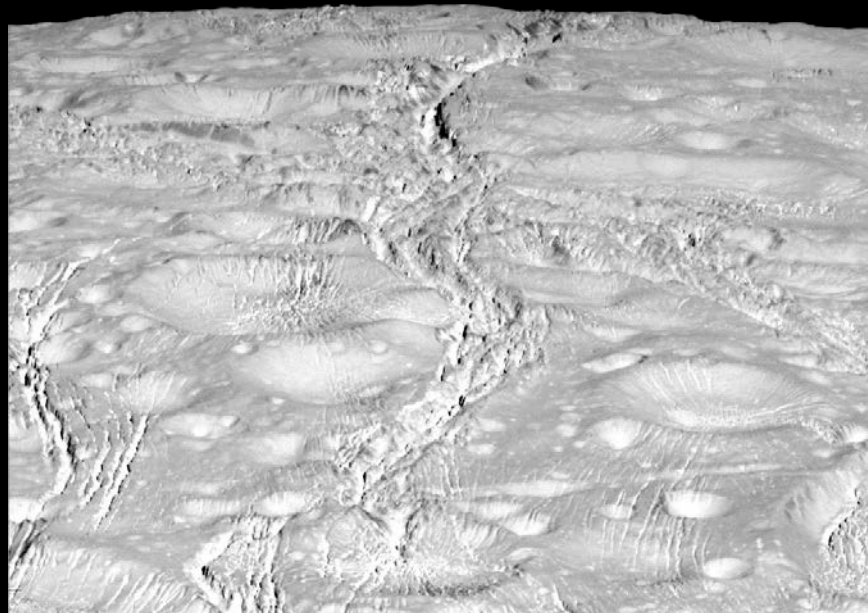
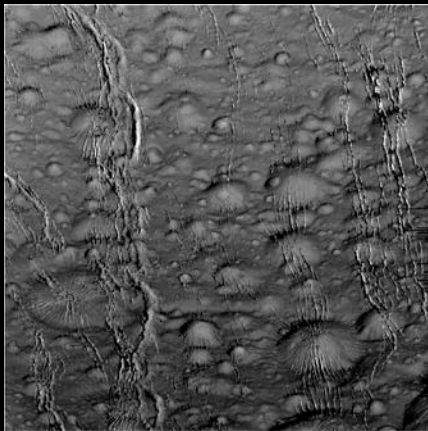
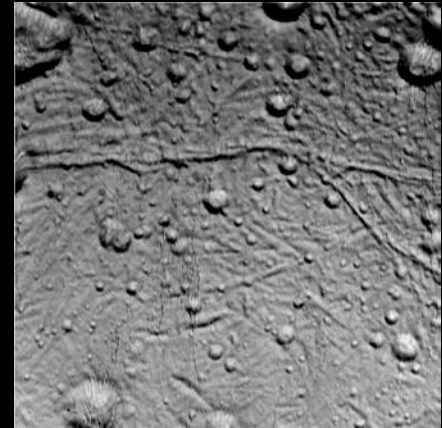
Enceladus' North Pole Revealed

Oct. 14, 2015



On October 14 2015, Cassini captured its final views of the northern polar region of Enceladus, which was unilluminated earlier in the mission.

Scientists will use these observations to look for indications that the north polar region was geophysically active at some time in the past.
