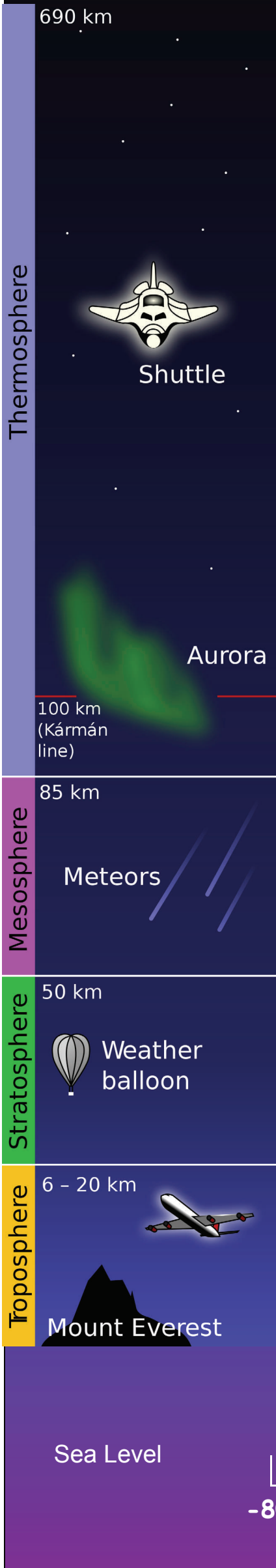


CAN YOU TAKE THE (LOW) PRESSURE?



Earth's atmosphere becomes thinner with height — the air pressure decreases at higher and higher altitudes.

In our atmosphere's lowest layers, the temperature also decreases at higher altitudes. The temperature on Mt. Everest is much chillier than at the beach!
