February

Community Kick-off February 15th

March

- CLOC-SAT self nominations close March 4th
- Full team established in mid March
- White paper submissions close March 31st

April - July

- CLOC-SAT develops integrated strategy and recommendations from community input
- Preliminary report findings presented at Exploration Science Forum in late July

August

- Revise drafts based on community feedback
- Final Report delivered to LEAG and NASA
- Final report findings presented at LEAG Annual Meeting in late August



- CLOC-SAT seeks to represent the lunar community through an open call for membership
 - Members are sought with diverse backgrounds across relevant science and technical areas
 - Members will meet virtually several times a month from April through August
 - All members will contribute to the report, coordinated by the co-chairs
- Nomination Format
 - CV / Resume (maximum 2 pages)
 - Statement of Interest (maximum 1 page or ~600 word email)

Call for White Papers

- White paper are the most direct way to provide information into CLOC-SAT discussions
 - It is essential that a broad range of interests and concerns are heard as well as specific recommendations.
 - Include elements of **Why** (rationale), **What** (specific recommendations), **How** (orbit, timing, data rate needs) as appropriate.
- Format
 - Cover page including co-authors / signatories
 - Recommended maximum main body length of 3 pages
 - Unlimited references or links (provide complete info: e.g. authors, title, journal, year, etc.)
