NASA prefers that the nuggets are for work that has been published, so that they know it has been peer reviewed and that if it gets shared to a broader audience we aren't concerned about the issue of embargo.

- Needs to be self-contained, understood by a wide audience, including a takeaway statement that indicates why the result is important
