



The purpose of this workshop is to provide a forum for discussion and exchange of new ideas and approaches to the investigation of aeolian processes that form and maintain dune fields on Earth and other planetary bodies within the solar system.

The workshop format will be similar to the five preceding workshops: 2.5 days of topical discussions, a poster session/social, and a one-day field trip to Great Sand Dunes National Park and Preserve. One session will be dedicated to white papers in preparation for the Planetary Decadal Survey. The workshop will conclude with a discussion session to review the week's highlights and ensure capture of important insights.
