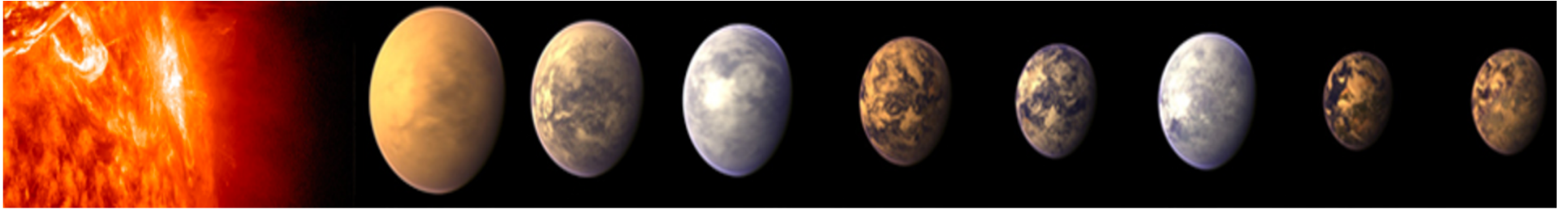
What is the CCTP?

- Comparative Climatology of Terrestrial Planets
- A cross-divisional workshop including Earth, planetary, astro, helio
- Addresses issues across (exo)planetary targets, including Earth
- Often led by Venus community, works through VEXAG
- This will be the third meeting:
 - The first was held in Boulder, CO in 2012
 - The second was held in Moffett Field, CA (NASA Ames) in 2015
